All landowners within the District desiring to subscribe and purchase a service connection or connections must first make written application to the Board of Directors of Comanche County Rural Water District No. 3.

The Board of Directors will not consider the application until it has had time to submit the application to its engineer and attorney as hereinafter set forth.

APPROVAL OF ENGINEER

Prior to application being considered by the Board of Directors, as set forth above, the desired number and location of the service connection(s) shall be submitted to the District's engineer for study and evaluation, and shall obtain written approval by said engineer.

APPROVAL OF ATTORNEY

Upon receiving approval from the District's engineer, the Board of Directors shall submit the application, letter of approval from the engineer, and other supporting documents to the District's attorney for review. The Board shall receive a letter of approval from said attorney.

EXPENSES

All expenses incurred by reason of purchase of a service connection or connections shall be borne by the landowner desiring membership, said expenses including but not limited to the following: engineer fees, attorney fees, district membership fee, impact & storage fees, expenses in material and installation of service connection(s), road bores, all line extensions and all other expenses in connection with the purchase and installation of the service connection(s). All expenses must be paid to Rural Water District No. 3, Comanche County upon submitting the application for membership to the Board of Directors for Approval. Upon completion of installation, all road bores, line extensions and meter connections shall become the property of Rural Water District No. 3, Comanche County and shall be maintained by the District.
